

Emergency Contact Data Sheets

Thank you to all of those parents who have returned their data sheets with emergency contact details. We have had some parents send in a sheet for one child, but not for brother or sisters who are at Glade.

Although the information may be the same, we record a sheet for every child so we need to have a separate sheet for each child. Please return any outstanding sheets as soon as possible.

School uniform

Nearly all of our children come to school wearing the correct uniform and I'd like to thank those parents who encourage their children to wear full uniform. We still have a few children not wearing the correct clothes. The main issues are:

- **Footwear.** We allow plain black shoes/trainers. Some children are wearing big boots (often with fluffy bits!). These are fine to come to school in, but children need to have normal shoes for indoors.
- **PE kit.** Children need to have a PE kit for every PE lesson. They need a change of shirt (plain white T-shirt), black shorts and plimsoll/trainers. Some children are trying to do PE in their usual uniform. This leads to them wearing a sweaty uniform for the rest of the day which is not fair on them or on the rest of the class.
- **Coats.** Given the cold weather, children must have a coat for school. It is too cold for them to be outside for an hour in shirt/jumper.
- **Makeup/jewellery.** No makeup or jewellery is permitted, except for one small plain stud per ear. We are still getting a number of girls coming to school wearing bracelets, hoop earrings and nail polish.

We all take pride in being part of the Glade community and wearing the correct uniform is a part of that. If your child brings home a uniform reminder slip, please help them out by making sure they have the correct uniform the next day.

Absences

Please make sure that you send in a note after any absence so that we can keep an accurate record of why children have been absent from school. Thanks.
