Parents will receive individual letters about this later this week, informing you of how to book an appointment. Those parents who attend the SEN consultation do not need to come to Parents, Evening.

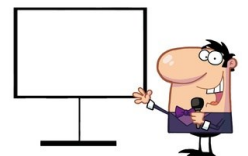
