Quotes from our adviser report

- All teaching observed showed evidence of consistently good teaching over time – with some outstanding features. It is no surprise therefore that most pupils and groups of pupils make good or better progress.
- Teachers throughout the school have high expectations, particularly of good behaviour. The GLADE learning behaviours' hand has enabled pupils to reflect upon and consider how this focus enables them to learn well.
- Every classroom presents as an orderly and calm learning environment where adults and children are encouraged to 'think and share' learning. On many occasions pupils are well mannered and polite. They sit quietly in a carefully constructed and interesting assembly and listen very well, participating when invited to do so.
- Teachers listen to pupils, observe them as they learn and praise good effort whenever they see it. All present learning as clear next steps with examples to use.
- Attendance is improving and above national for pupils in Years 1-6. Attendance in Reception is monitored and evaluated in line with the rest of the school.
