Level 6 - 2s, 5s, 10s, 3s, 4s, 8s, 9s, 6s multiplication & division

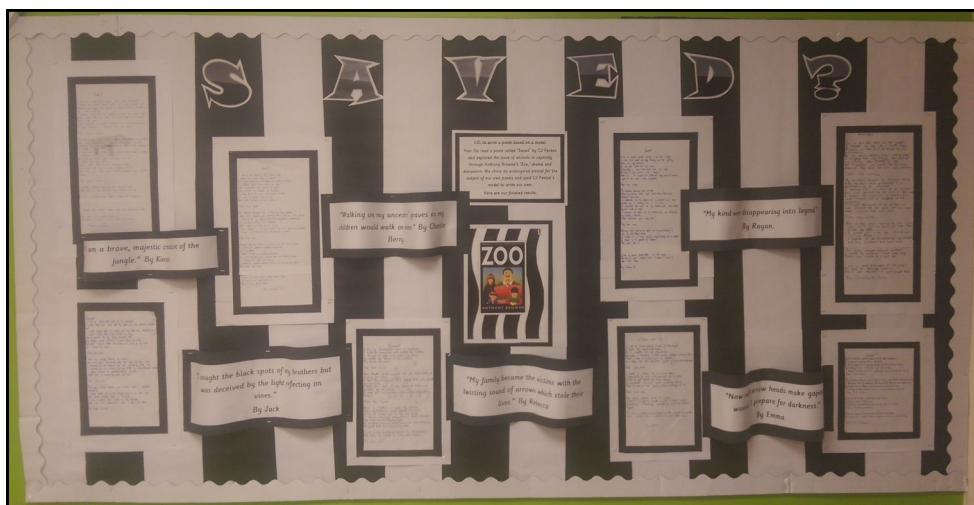
Level 7 - 2s, 5s, 10s, 3s, 4s, 8s, 9s, 6s, 7s, multiplication & division
