School Meals

At the last Parent Forum, a few parents brought up the issue of portion size with our school meals. This was also brought up by some members of Year 6. I have spoken with the area manager of EATS, the catering company that provide our school meals.

EATS have told us that the portions are planned to meet the dietary requirements for school meals and to fit with the costs charged to parents. Whilst the main course portion is fixed, children are able to have as much salad, vegetables and bread as they wished to supplement the main course.

Meals are priced the same, whether a child is 4 or 11 and are still cheaper than a Happy Meal (and far fresher!). All food is cooked on site, even the bread which is baked freshly that day in the school kitchen.
