A situation has arisen where parents who have received Penalty Notices due to their children having unauthorised absence have contacted the Education Welfare service and been told that the school are able to cancel the Penalty Notice.

The governing Body discussed this issue on Wednesday and have decided that where the school submits a Penalty Notice referral, this will not be cancelled. This has been done to ensure fairness to all parents. If one parent had a penalty notice cancelled and others did not, it creates an unfair situation. All parents are treated the same and only receive a penalty notice if there are 5 periods of unauthorised absence within a 12 week period.
