However, there are a handful of children who continue to act in away that goes against the ethos of our school. It tends to be low level behaviour, lack of homework, poor attitude towards learning, poor playground behaviour etc. We have decided that that if pupils continue to act in an inappropriate way, despite regular reminders, they will not be able to take part in our extra curricular activities; disco, clubs, Christmas Fair etc. We believe that these activities are for those children who behave in the right way.

We want all of our children to behave well in school and appreciate the support we have from parents in making sure this happens. Thank you.


