# **Complaints**

Like all organisations, we have a complaints procedure to ensure that any complaints are dealt with in a fair and prompt manner. If you should have cause for concern regarding your child, it is always wise, in the first instance, to seek the advice of the class teacher. Every attempt will be made to resolve 'problems' quickly and sensitively.

If your concerns should persist, it is best to make an appointment to speak to the KS leader, Deputy Headteacher or Headteacher. Again, every effort will be made to solve the problem quickly and effectively. Complaints of a more serious nature should be put in writing and given to the Headteacher.

If you are dissatisfied with how your written complaint has been handled, you may then write to the Chair of Governors via the school. All complaints are dealt with confidentially and fairly.

A copy of the full, detailed, complaints procedure may be obtained by asking at the school office.

The advice offered by the School Nurse is that the best method of prevention is by regular brushing and combing, and that if further action is required, advice can be obtained from the chemist.




# **Labelling school uniform**

# Safeguarding

Every child has the right to be safe from harm and danger. It is everyone's responsibility to ensure every child is free from fear and able to learn and develop in safe, secure environments. We have a duty to ensure that all children at Glade are kept safe.

Sometimes children tell us things that make us believe that they are not safe. If this happens we are obliged to take the matter further and refer it to Children and Young Peoples Services (CYP). The highly trained professionals at CYP then look into the matter to find out what has happened and what needs to happen to improve the safety and wellbeing of the child. This involves the parents and school working with CYP.

All schools have a Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL), responsible for Safeguarding. The DSL at Glade is Mr A Smith, the Headteacher. The Alternate DSLs are Mrs C Vincent and Mrs E Close. The Chair of Governors is Mrs Pamela Pickard and the named safeguarding governor is Mrs Jenny Cox, who can be contacted via the school office.
