You may have heard from the news that the Y2 Spelling & Grammar (SPAG) test has been cancelled. This is because the DfE accidentally leaked it on their website. The test is cancelled for this year, although the Y6 tests and the other Y2 tests are not affected.



We are busy planning the transition arrangements for our Y6 children leaving for high school, for our new Year R children joining us and to ensure that every child moves seamlessly into their new class.

There will be a parent meeting for parents of new intake Year R children at 6pm on Wednesday 15th June. More information will be sent home to parents of new Year R children early next month. Even if you have a child already at Glade, please make sure you come to the meeting. If you don't, you will miss out on important information.

Some parents have started asking about which class their child will be in next year. We don't make any decisions about which teacher teaches each class, or which children go into each class until the start of June. The decisions have not yet been made, so please don't ask!

What we can say is that we plan to open two extra classes so that there are no mixed age classes. We plan to have 2 classes in Reception, Y1, Y2 and Y3, with one class in Y4, one class in Y5 and one class in Y6. As well as no mixed age classes, some of the classes will only be around 20 pupils!
