We are changing how the Parent Forum operates and would like to recruit 2 parents per class to attend on a regular basis.



Building work

We have now received conformation that the building work will start at the end of the month. The contract has been awarded to the company who built the 2014 extension and will be run by the same team so we are looking forward to welcoming them back to Glade. The work to be completed includes:

- Relocation of the long trim trail and the "pick up sticks".
- Removal of a substantial number of trees.
- Removal of the wedge shaped area behind the mobile.
- Construction of a standalone 4 classroom block on the field where the current trim trail is.
- Construction of a new foyer at the front of the school.
- Landscaping of the area outside Swifts, Robins, the Roost & Skylarks to provide level access to classrooms as well as new cycle sheds.
- Conversion of Skylarks into a new staffroom.
- Construction of a corridor between Skylarks' inside and outside doors.
- Conversion of the current staffroom into a new office.
- Conversion of the current office into a meeting
- Replacement of the entire roof!

The mobile will stay during all of this. At a later date, 2 more classrooms will be added to the new block and then remove the mobile classrooms.

School Uniform

We have had a few incidences of children coming into school in the incorrect uniform. The main issues are:

Some children wearing summer dresses. These are only permitted during summer term when weather is much warmer. They are not suitable for the wet and cold winter days.

Children not wearing correct footwear. Children should wear plain black shoes. Trainers are not permitted. During the wet weather, children may come to school in wellies as long as they have a change of shoes for indoor use.
